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## Board Meeting Summary April 13, 2022 Statesboro, GA

Motions and Other Business:

- 1. Vice-Chair Willie C. Bolton called the meeting of the Board of Juvenile Justice to order on Wednesday, April 13, 2022, at 2:00 PM. (Chair Sandra Taylor had a family emergency and could not attend.)
- 2. Secretary Adam Kennedy moved for the approval of the agenda that was amended to include an executive session. It was seconded and approved unanimously.
