Board Meeting Minutes
(Audio/Zoom Conference)**

Opening Remarks

On Thursday, August 25, 2022. Chair Sandra Taylor called the joint meeting of the Boards of Juvenile Justice and Education to order at approximately 10:00 AM. The meeting was held as an in-person and audio/Zoom conference.
