Motions and Other Business:

1. Chair Sandra Taylor called the meeting of the Board of Juvenile Justice to order on Thursday, December 14, 2023, at approximately 10:05 AM.
2. Vice-Chair Wille Bolton moved to approve the agenda. The motion was seconded and approved unanimously.
