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BOARD MEETING SUMMARY January 23, 2020

Motions and Other Business:

- 1. Chair Taylor called the meeting of the Board of Juvenile Justice to order on Thursday, January 23, 2020, at 10:02 AM.
- 2. A motion to approve the January 23, 2020 agenda was made, seconded, and approved unanimously.
- 3. A motion to approve the December 12, 2019 minutes was made, seconded, and approved unanimously.
- 4. The Commissioner's report was included in the materials. Commissioner Tyrone Oliver provided some staff updates. Guests from Home Depot were recognized and welcomed. Commissioner Oliver talked about the body camera policy and implementation in the facilities as well as the community. Board member Edwards discussed the empirical, evidence-based effect of the use of body cameras. Board member Stephens suggested looking at policies of other school districts. Board member Yarbrough asked about the number of body cameras currently being utilized.
- 5. Commissioner Oliver also mentioned the restructuring of the secure facilities leadership, and he provided turnover rates and new hire status. He also discussed budget hearings being conducted by the General Assembly and recommendations for the required budget cuts.
