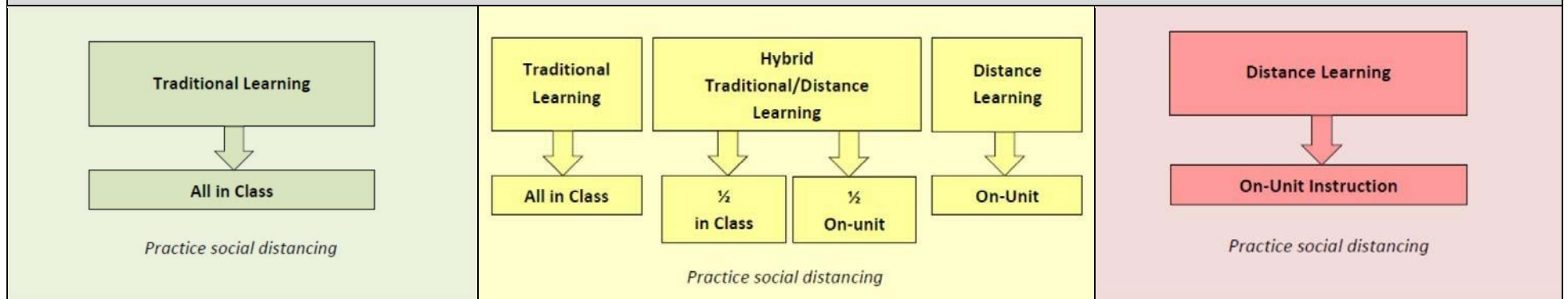

Preventive Practices	Mitigation Measures	Temporary Closure(s)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Follow DJJ, State & Federal (CDC) guidance ➤ Recommend COVID testing and vaccination ➤ Follow recommendation of medical staff ➤ Follow handwashing guidelines. Wash your hands often. ➤ Cough/sneeze into your elbow ➤ Don't touch your face ➤ If you feel sick, stay home ➤ Self-report symptoms ➤ Post signage in schools ➤ Masks are <u>optional</u> for staff and students ➤ Clean and sanitize between classes ➤ Use Air Purifiers 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Use ALL Preventive Practices ➤ Design school days to maintain the safest environment possible ➤ If staff are exposed, recommend immediate testing: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Staff return to work if test results are negative ✓ Staff return to work with medical clearance ➤ Isolate and deep clean impacted classrooms and spaces ➤ Refer to Medical if student is ill ➤ Determine necessity of on-unit instruction ➤ Students who require computer-based instruction may work in computer labs ➤ Determine no school closure, partial school closure, or total school closure per facility by evaluating size and characteristics of students and staff populations and school size ➤ For on-unit instruction, single teacher per unit 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Use ALL Preventive Practices ➤ Determine total closure per facility by evaluating size and characteristics of student and staff populations and school size ➤ On-unit instruction ➤ Single teacher per unit ➤ Close off affected areas and if possible, wait 24 hours before cleaning and disinfecting.
