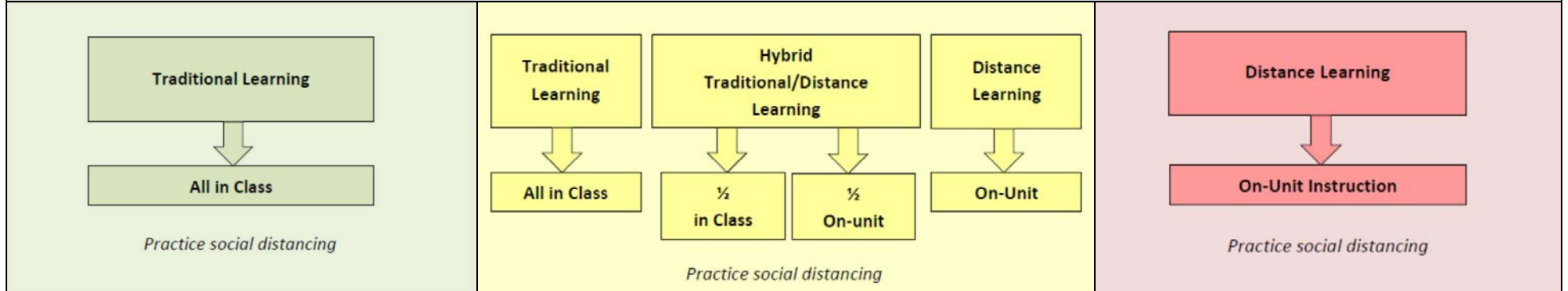

Practicing Prevention and Responding to COVID-19

Preventive Practices	Mitigation Measures	Temporary Closure(s)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Follow DJJ, State & Federal guidance ➤ Recommend COVID testing and vaccination ➤ Follow recommendation of medical staff ➤ Do the Five: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Wash your hands 2. Cough/sneeze into your elbow 3. Don't touch your face 4. Stay more than 6 feet apart 5. If you feel sick, stay home ➤ Self-report symptoms ➤ Post signage in schools ➤ Masks are optional for staff and students ➤ Clean and sanitize between classes 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Preventive practices ➤ School has the option to design their school days to promote social distancing and maintain the safest environment possible ➤ If staff are exposed, recommend immediate testing: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Staff return to work if test results are negative ✓ Staff return to work with medical clearance ➤ Isolate and deep clean impacted classrooms and spaces ➤ Refer to Medical if student is ill ➤ Determine necessity of on-unit instruction ➤ Students who require computer-based instruction may work in computer labs ➤ Determine no school closure, partial school closure, or total school closure per facility by evaluating size and characteristics of students and staff populations and school size ➤ For on-unit instruction, single teacher per unit 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Preventive practices ➤ Determine total closure per facility by evaluating size and characteristics of student and staff populations and school size ➤ On-unit instruction ➤ Single teacher per unit ➤ Close off affected areas and if possible, wait 24 hours before cleaning and disinfecting.

 <p>FACE COVERING & SOCIAL DISTANCING</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Staff and students are optional to wear masks ➤ Recommend students must remain 3 feet apart ➤ Recommend teachers remain 6 feet from students ➤ All education-related meetings will be held in the conference room and/or virtually 	 <p>TEMPERATURE CHECKS</p>	<p>If you feel or think you have a fever, see the medical staff at the facility.</p>	 <p>HAND WASHING</p>	<p>Staff and students will follow handwashing guidelines established by the CDC and posted throughout the building.</p>
