Motions and Other Business:

- 1. Vice-Chairman Menefee called the meeting of the Board of Juvenile Justice to order at 10:00 a.m. in the Board Room located at 3408 Covington Highway, Decatur, GA.

- 3. A motion to approve the agenda was made, seconded, and approved unanimously.
