Identify how the agency's efforts presented themselves in a manner that would lend strength, dignity and credit to the profession of law enforcement.

Show what impact the department's efforts have had on the academy association, law enforcement and/or the community.

Show additional law enforcement and/or community involvement by the agency.

The award is named for Phyllis Goodwin, who worked with the FBI for almost 38 years. During most of those years she served as the police training tech and she assisted officers who wanted to attend the national academy.

The presentation of the award was made at the organization's annual summer banquet, which took place last month.
