Department of Juvenile Justice Hiring in August During DJJ "Summer of Opportunity" Atlanta & Marietta

(STATEWIDE - GA) As the month of August comes to an end, the "Summer of Opportunity" continues at the Human Resources Office for Georgia's Department of Juvenile Justice. Commissioner Avery D. Niles announced there are two more recruiting fairs at the end of the agency's August recruitment calendar.

DJJ's recruiting team will be in the Atlanta Metro Area the last week of August, breaking out boxes of application forms and hoping to connect with job seekers looking for full time careers working with Georgia's juvenile offenders. "DJJ offers excellent career opportunities to both civilian and veteran applicants who are looking for professional employment in juvenile corrections," said Commissioner Avery Niles.

"The State of Georgia is an excellent career destination for returning veterans. Our Human Resources Team has been setting up tables at career fairs all over Georgia," said Commissioner Niles. "However would-be candidates need to know in advance that we're only seeking mature, responsible adults who are interested in helping these young offenders find their way through very troubled transitions in their lives," Niles said.

During the end of August, DJJ will be conducting two career fairs in the Atlanta Metro Area on the same day, targeting eligible applicants with both civilian and military backgrounds:
