“Job seekers with special skills and initiative should dress for success and bring their resumes to these job fairs to jumpstart a fulltime juvenile corrections career with the state of Georgia,” said Commissioner Avery Niles. “These juvenile corrections positions require mature applicants who can be dedicated to helping young offenders through troubled life-transitions.”

DJJ recruiters are authorized to hire qualified candidates at the career fairs. These positions offer full time employment with State of Georgia benefits package and military incentives for applicants who have served honorably with the Armed Forces.

In order to move successfully through the interview process for Juvenile Corrections Officers, candidates should bring copies of the following:

- Compass Scores (Reading 70 Writing 32)**
- Valid Driver License
- Birth Certificate
- High School Diploma or GED
- DD214 Long Form with indicated discharge
- Naturalization Forms if NON-US Citizen
- If P.O.S.T. Certified, (Please bring two (2) forms of Gov. issued ID & P.O.S.T. Profile)

**** If the applicant has a 4-year degree from an accredited college they are exempt from having to take the Compass test or provide proof of acceptable ACT or SAT scores.**

DJJ recruiters at the December 18th career fair in Rockdale will also be seeking applications for Food Services Employee, Housekeeper, and Nurse Manager positions as well as JCO2 Shift Supervisors with 18 months of experience. Job seekers can click on www.djjcareers.org for more information about career opportunities for applicants seeking professional employment in juvenile corrections.

Applicants who have served in the Armed Forces should also click on the section at www.djjcareers.org about “DJJ Careers for Veterans” to learn more about DJJ's one-time Military Salary Increase Incentive on eligible job titles to current and former military service members, who have served on active duty. To be eligible, service members must have an Honorable Discharge. The one-time incentive is based upon the current number of active duty years served.
