ACADEMY To HOLD TITLE I-A PARENT WORKSHOPS To PREPARE for GEORGIA MILESTONES ASSESSMENT

(DECATUR, GA) – The Georgia Preparatory Academy at the Department of Juvenile Justice (DJJ) will hold Title I-A district-wide workshops this month to inform DJJ parents how to help prepare their high school students to succeed with Common Core and Georgia Milestones Assessments.

The Georgia Milestones Assessment is a comprehensive summative assessment program for measuring how well students have learned the knowledge and skills outlined in the state-adopted content standards in language arts, math, science, and social studies. High school students will take an end-of-course (EOC) assessment for each of the eight courses designated by the State Board of Education.
