## DJJ Hiring in October!

### Georgia Department of Juvenile Justice Recruiting Statewide:

**(STATEWIDE-GA)** Looking for full-time employment and a challenging career that also will help make a real difference in your community? Recruiters from the Department of Juvenile Justice (DJJ) are conducting a month-long candidate search in 11 Georgia communities during October to fill professional positions for teachers, Registered Nurses (RN) and Juvenile Corrections Officers (JCOs).

Agency representatives will be active at career fairs across the state. DJJ recruiters will be in Albany, Atlanta, Augusta, Dahlonega, Dalton, Dublin, Hazlehurst, Lovejoy, Moody AFB, Savannah and Tucker. The agency is offering employment opportunities at secure facilities throughout Georgia's juvenile justice system.

DJJ Commissioner Avery D. Niles said, **"We want candidates who are looking for 'the' place to make their work count. We want motivated applicants who can commit to helping young offenders from our communities overcome their troubled life transitions while in our custody."** The department is searching for highly qualified teachers and RNs, as well as JCO candidates to fill DJJ's upcoming training classes.

The Commissioner said, **"We're hiring jobseekers with a personal drive to become part of a dedicated team of juvenile justice professionals. In addition, DJJ is always looking for mature, responsible adult candidates and applicants with prior experience in corrections, the military or law enforcement."**
