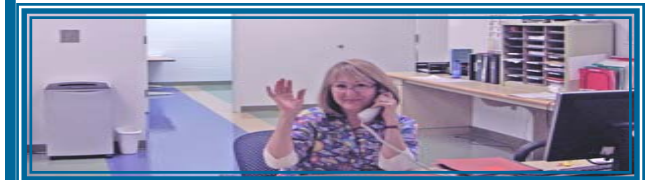

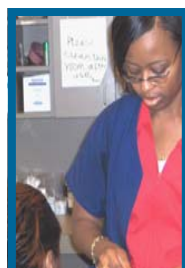
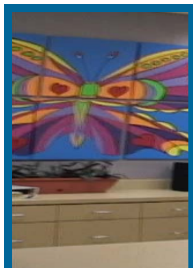

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

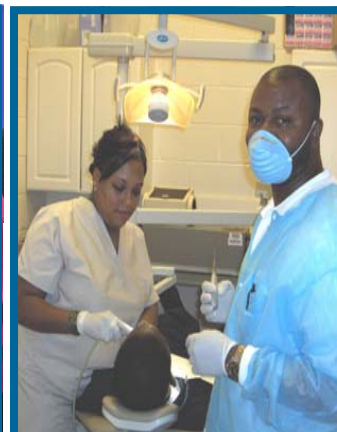
A current Georgia license to practice as a registered professional nurse.

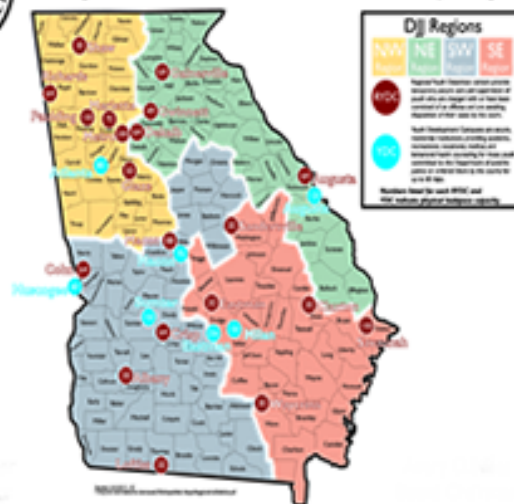


Note: In addition to actively seeking RN's and LPN's we are seeking Nurse Practitioners, Physician Assistants, Dentists and part-time Physicians.
